RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is a pressing and definite need for recreational facilities in the Southern California area to further the public welfare, and

WHEREAS, Lake Mathews in the County of Riverside has an excellent recreational potential, as yet undeveloped; and

WHEREAS, this Board believes that said lake can be used by the public for recreational purposes without interfering with the activities of the Metropolitan Water District or endangering the supply of potable water; and

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside is willing to cooperate in plans and preparations for the public recreational use of said lake; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on February 23, 1960, that this Board requests that the Metropolitan Water District sanction the use of Lake Mathews for recreational purposes by the public, upon such conditions as may be reasonable and necessary, and that the Board of Directors of said District adopt a policy to that effect and make known to this Board of Supervisors what assistance it can render.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies hereof be forwarded to the Board of Directors of the Metropolitan Water District.
